


## Installing the Internet Edition of QAX.

These step by step instructions are intended for students or teachers installing QAX at home.

If you have an existing version of QAX on your computer then you need to uninstall it. To Uninstall QAX click on **start** and then **Control Panel**. Open **Add or Remove Programs** and then select QAX and **Remove** it.

To install the internet student edition of QAX you will need to have the student registration number provided to you by your school and your user ID and password.



**Vista** users should save this file

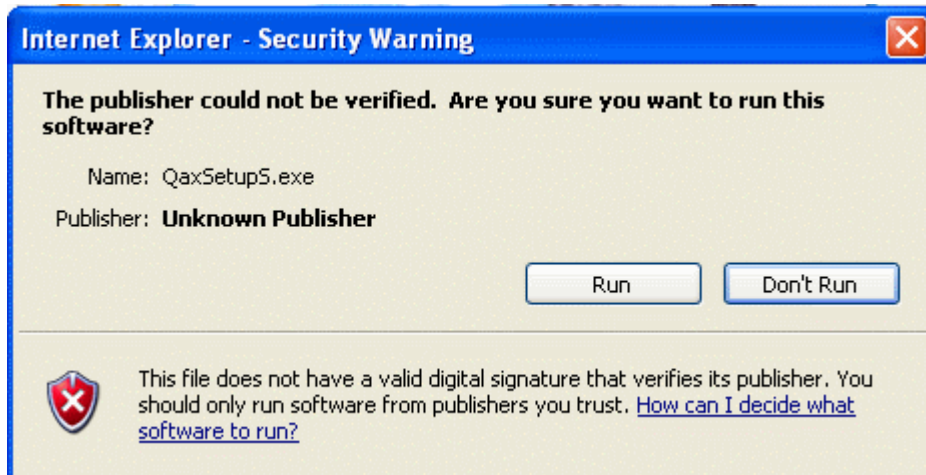
If you click on **Run** the program will install now.



## Installing the Internet Edition of QAX.

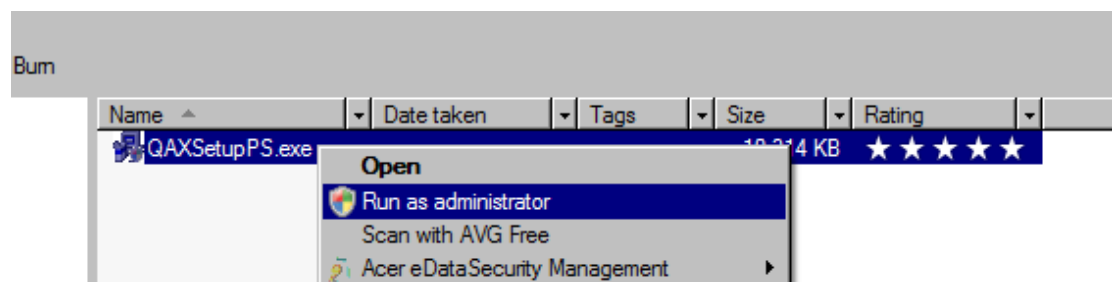
Note: If you are using Trend Micro anti virus, then turn it off and turn on again after the installation is complete. Trend Micro thinks the setup file has a Trojan in it and will block it. We have tested the files extensively and they are clean.

The program will download and then the following Security Warning will appear.



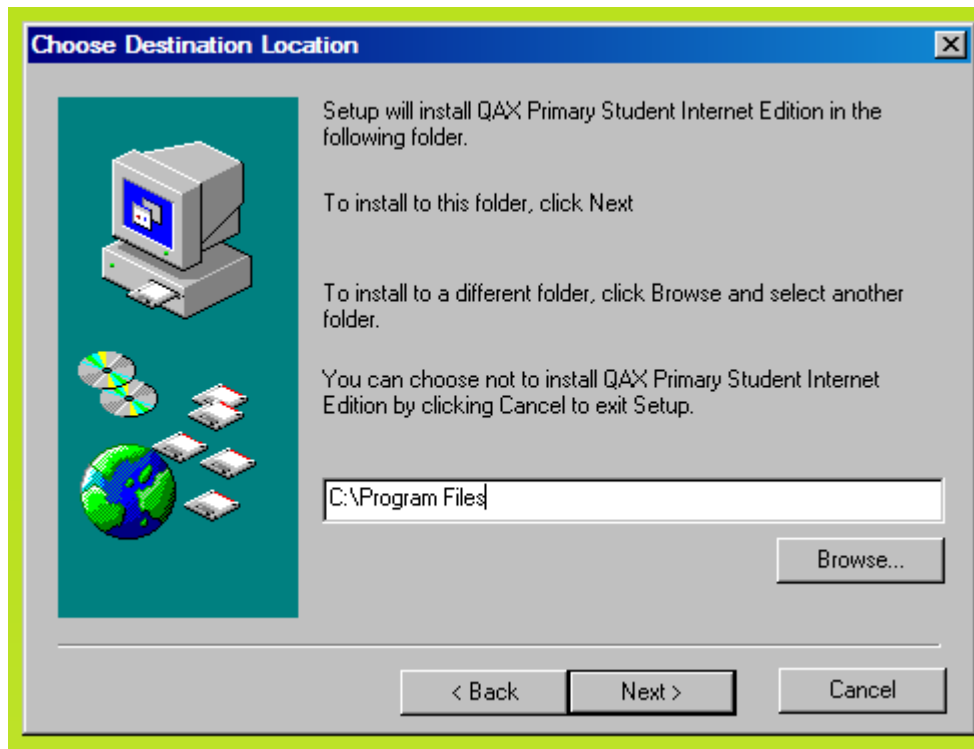
Click on **Run.**

Vista users, right click on the setup file and select **Run as Administrator.**

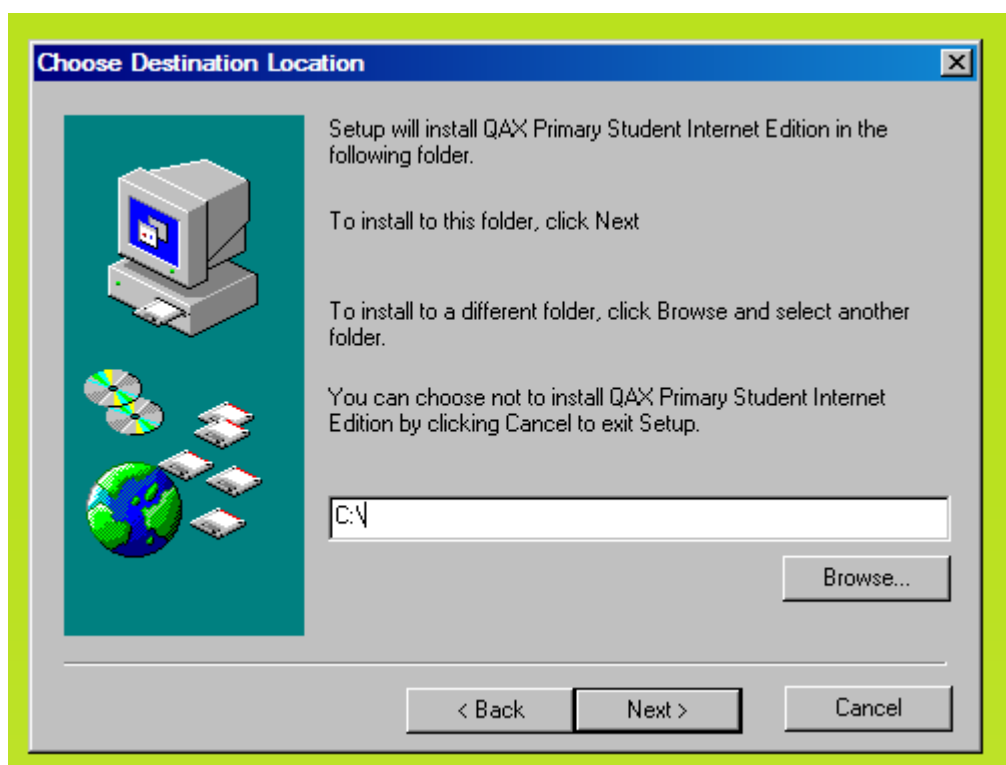


QAX will now start installing itself. Click on Next or Yes at each stage of the process.

## Installing the Internet Edition of QAX.



Choose Destination location, if you are using **XP** then leave as is unless you would prefer another location.



If you are using **Vista** then change destination location to C:\, or another location of your choice, as long as you **do not** install to C:\Program Files

## Installing the Internet Edition of QAX.

At the end of the process run QAX. You will be asked to register your copy.



Enter the registration number supplied to you by your school and click on **OK**. You can then log on using your user ID and password.

If windows asks you if you want to unblock your firewall to for QAX then say Yes.
